

Access Active X settings

Open Internet Explorer 7

Under Tools menu choose Internet Options

Click the Security tab in the resulting window

Click the Custom Level button to open the Active X settings

Under ActiveX controls and plug-ins the settings should be:

Automatic prompting for ActiveX controls: **Enable**

Binary and script behaviors: **Enable**

Download signed ActiveX controls: **Prompt**

Download unsigned ActiveX controls: **Prompt**

Initialize and script ActiveX controls not marked safe: **Prompt**

Run ActiveX controls and plug-ins: **Enable**

Script ActiveX controls marked safe for scripting: **Enable**

Under Downloads the settings should be:

Automatic prompting for file downloads: **Enable**

File Download: **Enable**

Click Ok to close the window. You may get a warning that you are changing security settings. Click Yes to close that window. Click Ok on the Internet Options to close it. Close all browser windows and re-launch Internet Explorer.

These settings should also work with IE 6.
